Gas Cylinder Safety Tips

Attention When Replacing Gas Cylinders
or Butane Canisters:

After replacing the gas cylinder or butane canister, make sure the gas hose (or butane canister latch) is securely connected, with no gas odor detected, before turning it on.

Always turn off the stove and put out any nearby flames before beginning the replacement process.

When opening the cylinder valve, avoid turning it fully open to prevent the valve from jamming and becoming hard to close.

Additional Safety Tips:

- Use only certified stoves, portable gas cookers, and canisters that meet safety standards.
- Store gas cylinders and butane canisters away from flames and in safe, secure locations.
- If a gas leak is detected, immediately put out nearby flames and avoid using or turning on any electrical devices.
- Have the replacement process handled or supervised by experienced personnel or professionals.
- When buying gas from a supplier, refer to the "Domestic LPG Supply Standard Contract" (家用液化石油氣供氣定型化契約範本) issued by the Ministry of the Interior and the Ministry of Economic Affairs to safeguard your rights and avoid disputes.
